Privacy Policy

ADAPSBTRANSE PTY LTD is committed to providing quality services to its stakeholders and this policy outlines adapsbtranse ongoing obligations to its stakeholders in respect of how the stakeholders Personal Information is managed.

Adapsbtranse has adopted the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs) contained in the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) (the Privacy Act). The APPs govern the way in which adapsbtranse collects, uses, discloses, stores, secures and disposes of stakeholders Personal Information.

What is Personal Information and why does adapsbtranse collect it?

Personal Information is information or an opinion that identifies an individual. Examples of Personal Information adapsbtranse collects includes: names, addresses, email addresses, phone and facsimile numbers.

This Personal Information is obtained in many ways including **(interviews, correspondence, by telephone and facsimile, by email, from stakeholders adapsbtranse website, from media and publications, from other publicly available database)** and from third parties. Adapsbtranse doesn't guarantee website links or policy of authorised third parties.

Adapsbtranse collects stakeholders Personal Information for the primary purpose of providing adapsbtranse services to stakeholders, providing information to adapsbtranse clients and marketing. Adapsbtranse may also use stakeholders Personal Information for secondary purposes closely related to the primary purpose, in circumstances where stakeholders would reasonably expect such use or disclosure. Stakeholders may unsubscribe from adapsbtranse mailing/marketing lists at any time by contacting adapsbtranse in writing.

When adapsbtranse collects Personal Information adapsbtranse will, where appropriate and where possible, explain to stakeholders why adapsbtranse is collecting the information and how adapsbtranse plans to use it.

Sensitive Information

Sensitive information is defined in the Australian Privacy Act to include information or opinion about such things as an individual's racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, membership of a political association, religious or philosophical beliefs, membership of a trade union or other professional body, criminal record or health information.

Sensitive information will be used by us only:

- For the primary purpose for which it was obtained
- For a secondary purpose that is directly related to the primary purpose
- With stakeholder's consent; or where required or authorised by law.

Third Parties

Where reasonable and practicable to do so, adapsbtranse will collect stakeholders Personal Information directly and only from stakeholders. However, in some circumstances adapsbtranse may be provided with information by third parties. In such a case adapsbtranse will take reasonable steps to ensure that stakeholders are made aware of the information provided to us by the third party.

Disclosure of Personal Information

Stakeholders Personal Information may be disclosed in many circumstances including the following:

- Third parties where stakeholders consent to the use or disclosure; and
- Where required or authorised by law.

Security of Personal Information

Stakeholders Personal Information is stored in a manner that reasonably protects it from misuse and loss and from unauthorized access, modification or disclosure.

When stakeholders Personal Information is no longer needed for the purpose for which it was obtained, adapsbtranse will take reasonable steps to destroy or permanently de-identify stakeholders Personal Information. However, most of the Personal Information is or will be stored in client files which may be kept by adapsbtranse for a minimum of 7 years.

Access to Stakeholders Personal Information

Stakeholders may access the Personal Information that adapsbtranse holds about stakeholders and to update and/or correct it, subject to certain exceptions. If stakeholders wish to access stakeholders Personal Information, then they have to make a submission to adapsbtranse in writing.

In order to protect stakeholders Personal Information adapsbtranse will verify the identification from stakeholders before releasing the requested information.

Maintaining the Quality of stakeholders Personal Information

It is an important to us that stakeholders Personal Information is up to date. Adapsbtranse will take reasonable steps to make sure that stakeholders Personal Information is accurate, complete and up-to-date. If stakeholders find that the information that adapsbtranse has is not up to date or is inaccurate, then they can advise adapsbtranse as soon as practicable so records are up to date and ensure that adapsbtranse can continue to provide quality services to the stakeholders.
